(\$482,054.00)**

**WHEREAS**, by way of Resolution No. 614-10-2020, this Board awarded funds from the New Jersey State Department of Labor and Workforce Development Board for the Workfirst New Jersey Welfare Reform Program for the period of July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the amount awarded was **FOUR MILLION SIX HUNDRED SIXTY-FIVE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$4,665,773.00)**; and

**WHEREAS**, by way of Resolution No. 615-10-2020, this Board accepted funds from the Hudson County/Jersey City Workforce Development Board for its fiscal agent, the Department of Family Services in the amount of **FOUR MILLION TWENTY TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY SEVEN DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$4,022,627.00)** for allotments for Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) and General Assistance (GA); and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Family Services as fiscal agent for the Workforce Development Board now wishes to allocate funds to the Jersey City Employment and Training Program for the Workfirst New Jersey Program in the amount of **FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY TWO THOUSAND FIFTY FOUR DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$482,054.00)** for Program Year 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds were provided to the Hudson County/Jersey City Workforce Development Area and it is advantageous for the County to award these funds to the Jersey City Employment and Training Program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Hudson, that:


1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
