WHEREAS, by way of a Resolution No. 370-6-2017, citing to a Notice of Obligation, dated May 30, 2017, from the New Jersey State Department of Labor and Workforce Development, the County of Hudson was awarded funds in the amount of FIVE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY ONE DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$5,572,491.00); and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to fund the continuation of the Workfirst New Jersey Welfare Reform; and

WHEREAS, these funds must be fully obligated by June 30, 2018 and fully expended by December 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Family Services now desires to award funds for the Workfirst NJ allotments awarded by the Notice of Obligation; and

WHEREAS, the allotments are not subject to "Pay to Play" requirements as they emanated from a fair and open competitive process pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Hudson County Department of Family Services will have the authority to adjust funding levels during the contract period for various services within the approved overall agency allocations, based upon customer utilization of these activities; and

WHEREAS, the recommendations are consistent with the Workfirst New Jersey Regulations in the stated amounts for the period of July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018:
