AND TO EXTEND THE PROGRAM FOR THREE MONTHS
JULY 1, 2019 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2020
(\$351,000.00)

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution No. 445-7-2019, this Board approved the award of contracts to training providers which funds emanated from the New Jersey State Department of Labor and Workforce Development for Workfirst New Jersey services; and

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution No. 722-11-2019, this Board approved the reallocation and de-obligation of Workforce Development funds to vendors; and

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution No. 35-1-2020, this Board further approved the reallocation and de-obligation of Workfirst New Jersey services to vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Workfirst New Jersey Program year was extended for three (3) months due to the Covid-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the State Department of Labor and Workforce Development issued a revised Notice of Award for Workfirst New Jersey funds in the amount of \$6,167,314.00 for Program year 2019 (July 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020) and an additional NINETY-TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$92,000.00) in Needs Based Work Support; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Family Services now seeks to allocate funds to performing agencies who are over enrolled and reduce funds awarded to underperforming agencies; and

WHEREAS, the recommendations are as follows in the stated amounts for the period of July 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Hudson, that:

- 1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
- 2. The Board hereby authorizes the County Executive, Thomas A. DeGise, or County Administrator, Abraham Antun, or Deputy County Administrator, David B. Drumeler, or their lawfully appointed designee, to execute any and all documents and take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this Resolution.
- The Board approves the reallocation and de-obligation of funds to vendors for the continuation of Workfirst New Jersey services.
- The Board hereby approves the payment to educational services providers for Workfirst New Jersey services.
- The Clerk to this Board shall attach a certified copy of this Resolution to the filed copies of Resolution Nos. 445-7-2019, 722-11-2019 and 35-1-2020.
- This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
