Hudson County Commissioners authorize the acceptance of funds from the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, State Homeland Security Program, Emergency Management, totaling \$465,625.

Hudson County- The Hudson County Board of Commissioners authorizes the acceptance of funds from the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, State Homeland Security Program, Emergency Management, totaling \$465,625.

The 2021 Grant is administered through the County of Hudson Office of Emergency Management to enhance and sustain all hazards emergency capabilities. This includes prevention measures, mitigation, protection, response and recovery activities. An all hazards approach to emergency management preparedness includes the development of a comprehensive program of planning, training, and exercise which will provide an effective and consistent response to any disaster or emergency.

This funding will be used to build, maintain and sustain national preparedness capabilities through target hardening, video surveillance, automobile license plate reader, hazmat, high rise equipment (nozzles), high rise pump operator hits, fire coordinator laptop, and communications-portable radio.

The grant will begin October 1, 2021 and run through September 30, 2024.

An essential approach in achieving goals and target capabilities involves establishing strong working relationships with neighboring jurisdictions. Relationships are necessary for developing performance capabilities that leverage joint operations, mutual aid, support local, regional, state to state, and nationwide priorities when responding to a catastrophic event.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and The Hudson County Board of Commissioners are committed to providing the necessary resources to assist local municipalities in enhancing and sustaining their all hazards emergency management capabilities.
