Hudson County- The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved funds from the NJ Department of Labor and Workforce Development to Temporary Assistance for the Needy Families (TANF) and Initiative for Parents Program (TIPS) totaling \$160,000.

Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) will improve parenting skills and encourage the child's well-being and healthy development. TIP offers parents the opportunity to choose between having a TIP representative come directly to their home to work one on one with them or participating in community sessions at their local One Stop Career Center. Parents are also given the opportunity to share their experiences with families like themselves and are referred to other services they may need.

The funds will be utilized to provide academic remediation, vocational training, employment referral, and supportive services that assist clients in securing employment and or becoming self-sufficient. These services are

being provided to Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) and Initiative for Parents Program (TIPS).

The term of this grant is from January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners are committed to providing the necessary resources needed to assist county residents in acquiring educational training in order for them to obtain gainful employment.
