Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved accepting a \$173,250 grant from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development Opportunity Partnership Training Grant for Job Training.

Jersey City-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved accepting a \$173,250 grant from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Work Force Development Opportunity Partnership Training Grant for Job Training.

The purpose of the grant is to provide Supportive Assistance to individuals in order to continue or enhance their employability through basic education skills training and job search/readiness services. The Opportunity Partnership Training Grant is to provide training opportunities within the State's targeted industry sectors as identified by the Department of Labor thus creating a pathway to employment for qualified unemployed jobseekers.

The Hudson County/ Jersey City Workforce Development Board have extensive expertise overseeing contractual agreements to support workforce training programs within its jurisdiction. These trainings are contractually executed by the Workforce Development Board.

The grant is for fiscal year June 1, 2021 to May 31, 2022.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and the Board of Chosen Commissioners are committed in their resolve in providing the necessary training resources needed to assist county residents in obtaining and maintaining gainful employment.

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
