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Immediate Release

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The County has been advised that it will receive \$130,694,069 in stimulus funds pursuant to the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Plan Act also known as the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (the "ARP").

The ARP funds will be used for the benefit of Hudson County and its municipalities and eligible agencies to combat the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Hudson County Schools of Technology (the "School") has advised that there is a project the School wishes to undertake at its various campuses which will enhance the safety measures by the School in order to combat the impact of the COVID-19 virus and which would also be eligible for funding through the use of ARP funds.

The project identified by the School envisions the installation of UV room sanitizers in classrooms and active spaces throughout the School buildings (the "Project").

The School has advised the County that the cost to undertake the Project will exceed \$500,000.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners wishes to support the School in connection with the Project by supplementing the funding already identified by the School by allocating the sum of TWO HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS, (\$260,000.00) to the School from the ARP funds received by the County.

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
