Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved a grant application and acceptance of \$9,655,035.12, if approved, from the North Jersey Department of Transportation for Local Freight Impact Fund to create a Jersey City-Newark Turnpike Improvement Project

Hudson County- The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved a grant application and acceptance of \$9,655,035.12, if approved, from the North Jersey Department of Transportation for Local Freight Impact Fund to create a Jersey City-Newark Turnpike Improvement Project.

The project would receive funding to implement various improvements along the Jersey City-Newark corridor between Route 7 and Interstate 280 entrance ramp. This project is eligible to receive funding through this grant since the corridor contains more than 10% truck traffic. In fact, 15% Jersey City-Newark Turnpike corridor's daily truck traffic is 26,969. The scope of work will include reconstructing the corridor's pavement box, upgrading existing guide rails, end treatments, rub rails, installation of a new pump station, replacing catch basins, lateral pipes and upgrading the existing traffic signal at the United States Postal Service facility intersection.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners are providing the necessary resources needed to improve the Jersey City-Newark Turnpike corridor for the traveling public.
