Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved a Behavioral Health and Wellness Response Grant for allocation to various agencies by the County of Hudson for American Rescue Plan Act, totaling \$192,000

Hudson County- The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved a Behavioral Health and Wellness Response Grant for allocation to various agencies by the County of Hudson for American Rescue Plan Act, totaling \$192,000.

The County has been advised that it will receive \$192,000 in stimulus funds pursuant to the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Plan Act also known as the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (the “ARP”).

The ARP funds will be used for the benefit of Hudson County and its municipalities and eligible agencies to combat the COVID-19 pandemic.

The following agencies are receiving funds under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 Behavioral Health and Wellness Response Grant: Women Rising, Domestic Violence Services, \$50,000, Mount Carmel Guild, Mental Health Services for Adults in Identified Community Agencies, \$67,000, Haven Adolescent Community Respite Services, Mental Health and Temporary Day Respite Services for Youth and their Families, \$45,000, and Haven Adolescent Community Respite Services, Mental Health Wellness and Resiliency

Programing for Children and Youth, \$30,000 which will enhance safety measures by combating the impact of the COVID-19 virus.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners committed allocated the sum of \$192,000 from the ARP funds to various agencies to provide needed services to County residents.
