Jersey City-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson to accept the allocated funds from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources Services Administration Ryan White HIV/AIDS Part A grant programs, Office of Specialized Health Services totaling **\$263,000** for fiscal year 2022.

The purpose of the program is to provide services that include outpatient, ambulatory medical care, essential support services, medical case management services and other core medical and social services programs for those living in Hudson County with HIV/AIDS.

A plan for America is to end the HIV Epidemic. The funds are used to enhance the current HIV services to improve HIV-related health outcomes and prevent new transmissions by identifying people who are HIV newly diagnosed, HIV diagnosed and out of care, HIV diagnosed but never in HIV care and those who are not virally suppressed.

The program will run from January 1, 2022 to February 28, 2022.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and The Board of Commissioners are committed to providing the needed support services, referral services, and prevention services to the residents of Hudson County who are living with HIV/AIDS.
