**AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 511-9-2021  
TO  
DEOBLIGATE AND REALLOCATE FUNDS  
FOR THE CONTINUATION OF WORKFIRST NEW JERSEY SERVICES  
JULY 1, 2021 TO JUNE 30, 2022  
(\$350,000.00)**

**WHEREAS**, by way of Resolution No. 677-11-2020, this Board approved the award of fair and open competitive contract to providers of educational services, work preparation and training activities for Workfirst New Jersey clients pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4; and

**WHEREAS**, by way of Resolution No. 460-8-2021, this Board awarded funds for year two (2) to the educational services, work preparation and training activities providers; and

**WHEREAS**, by way of Resolution No. 511-9-2021, Resolution No. 460-8-2021 was amended to deobligate funds from Family Services Administration and reallocate those funds to the Hudson County/Jersey City Workforce Development Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Family Services now wishes to deobligate funds from under performing and over enrolled agencies and reallocate these funds to the performing agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds to be deobligated and reallocated are in the amount of **THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$350,000.00)**; and

**WHEREAS**, the recommendations are consistent with the Workfirst New Jersey regulations in the stated amounts for the period of July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 as follows:

Drumeler or their lawfully appointed designee to execute any and all documents and take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this Resolution.
3. The Board hereby approves the deobligation and reallocation of funds from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development for the educational and training services for Workfirst New Jersey clients for the above named providers for the above described purpose.
4. The Clerk to this Board shall attach a certified copy of this Resolution to the filed copies of Resolution Nos. 460-8-2021 and 511-9-2021

5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
