**Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved reallocating funds from NJ Department of Labor and Workforce Development to Temporary Assistance for the Needy Families (TANF) and Initiative for Parents Program (TIP) for Hudson County Residents totaling \$350,000**

***Hudson County-*** The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved additional funds from the NJ Department of Labor and Workforce Development to Temporary Assistance for the Needy Families (TANF) and Initiative for Parents Program (TIPS) for Hudson County residents totaling \$350,000.

The funds will be utilized to provide academic remediation, vocational training, employment referral, and supportive services that assist clients in securing employment and or becoming self-sufficient. These services are being provided to Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF) and Initiative for Parents Program (TIPS).

The four vendors who are receiving the additional funds are: Bright Horizon Institute, Dux Education, Educate the Block, and Pro Data, Inc.

The State Department of Labor and WorkForce Development for WorkFirst New Jersey (WFNJ) clients grant is for the present period and ending June 30, 2022.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners are committed to providing the necessary resources needed to assist county residents in acquiring educational training in order for them to obtain gainful employment.
