**Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson to accept the allocated funds from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources Services Administration Ryan White HIV/AIDS Part A Grant Program, Professional Services Providers totaling (\$1,432,366) for fiscal year 2022**

**Jersey City**-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson to accept the allocated funds from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources Services Administration Ryan White HIV/AIDS Part A grant programs, professional services providers totaling **\$1,432,366** for fiscal year 2022.

The purpose of the program is to provide services that include outpatient, ambulatory medical care, mental health, substance abuse, emergency assistance, emergency transportation, oral health services, home delivered meals, essential support services, medical case management services and other core medical and social services programs for those living in Hudson County with HIV/AIDS.

The Hudson County Department of Health and Human Services has recommended that the following agencies receive the following funds. Care Point, Hoboken University Medical Center received \$169,982 for medical case management, emergency assistance, outpatient primary medical services, mental health and substance treatment. Robert Wood Johnson Barnabas Health Jersey City Medical Center received \$1,156,697 for outpatient primary medical services, emergency assistance and transportation. Hudson

Improvement Authority received \$71,926. Hudson County Administration received \$33,220, Hudson County Improvement Authority \$71,925 for the Hudson County HIV/AIDS Planning Council. God's Love We Deliver received \$49,937 for home delivered meals. Hyacinth AIDS Foundation received \$27,500, Holmwood Data Consulting \$50,000, Jeff Murray's Programming Shop Inc \$16,816 and \$143,711 was unallocated.

The program will run from March 1, 2022 to February 28, 2023.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and The Board of Commissioners are committed to providing the needed support services, referral services, legal services, home delivered meals and prevention services to the residents of Hudson County who are living with HIV/AIDS.
