**Jersey City**-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners authorize 2022 budget amendment NJ Office of Homeland Security & Preparedness FFY22 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP) for \$471,856.99.

The grant period will start September1, 2022 and will run through July 31, 2025.

This 2022 Budget Amendment Resolution provides funds that will be used to build, maintain, and sustain national preparedness capabilities. This grant is monitored by Hudson County OEM and New Jersey Office of Homeland Security and Preparedness. The approved projects for the FFY22 SHSP grant are as follows:
