Jersey City-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners authorize 2022 budget amendment NJ Office of Homeland Security & Preparedness FFY22 Urban Areas Security Initiative Grant (UASI) for \$270,000.

The grant period will start September 1, 2022 and will run through July 31, 2025.

This 2022 Budget Amendment Resolution provides funds that will be used to enhance Hudson County's and the UASI's ability to build, maintain, and sustain national preparedness capabilities. The approved projects for the FFY22 UASI grant are as follows:
