**Jersey City-**The Hudson County Board of Commissioners authorizing an application for grant funds through the New Jersey Department of Transportation's (NJDOT) FY 2023 Transportation Alternative Set-Aside Grant Program (TAP) and accepting said funds, if awarded, up to \$1,500,000.

The Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program (TAP) provides federal funds for community based non-traditional surface transportation projects designed to strengthen the cultural, aesthetic, and environmental aspects of the nation's intermodal system.

The County of Hudson is applying for TAP funding to develop a biking and walking path along the Hackensack River within Jersey City. The proposed project will help to continue and improve the promotion and encouragement of pedestrian and bicycle access and safety for residents of Hudson County. The proposed project will also support regional plans to expand pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure to encourage transportation alternatives to driving. Once constructed, Hudson County will assume the maintenance of the facility.

Chairman Anthony Vainieri and the Board of Commissioners renew their commitment to offering the residents of Hudson County safe, alternative paths for pedestrian and bicycle travel.
