Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson, Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Inclusion and Accessibility, and Peer Grouping Funds totaling \$637,460.

Jersey City-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson, Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Inclusion and Accessibility, and Peer Grouping Funds totaling \$637,460.

The funds will be utilized by the Hudson County Department of Health and Human Services to help provide assistance to various service providers that will provide programs including but not limited to case management, emergency mental health, respite care, hospice, early intervention services, and medical supplies to Hudson County's most vulnerable residents, the elderly and individuals with disabilities.

The following government agencies will receive funding: ACT Now Foundation, seniors and adults with disabilities, \$11,760, ACT Now Foundation, caregivers of individuals with degenerative/chronic diseases, \$35,000, Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Newark, seniors and adults with disabilities, \$10,240, Heightened Independence and Progress, independent living case management, \$50,000, Heightened Independence and Progress, transition case management, \$30,000, Heightened Independence and Progress, assistive technology, \$55,000, Heightened Independence and Progress, therapeutic recreational services, \$13,460, Kennedy Dancers, Inc, therapeutic recreational services, \$10,000, Jersey City Medical Center/RWJ Barnabas Health,

community emergency psychiatric services, \$83,000, Salvation Army Early Childhood Education Center, child care for special populations, \$72,000, Team UP Counseling, therapeutic recreational services, \$10,000, United Cerebral Palsy of Hudson County, respite, \$62,000, Urban League of Hudson County, intergenerational intervention services, \$125,000, Visiting Homemaker Service of Hudson County, certified home health case management, \$30,000, Unallocated, \$40,000, Total \$637,460.

The grant period will be from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners are committed to addressing and providing the necessary resources to vulnerable residents, elderly and individuals with disabilities in need of assistance.
