Hudson County- The Hudson County Board of Commissioners authorizes the acceptance of funds from the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, Emergency Management Agency Assistance Grant, Subgrant Program totaling \$131,019.77.

The 2022 Grant is administered through the County of Hudson Office of Emergency Management to enhance and sustain all hazards emergency capabilities. This includes prevention measures, mitigation, protection, response and recovery activities. An all-hazards approach to emergency management preparedness includes the development of a comprehensive program of planning, training, and exercise which will provide an effective and consistent response to any disaster or emergency.

An essential approach in achieving goals and target capabilities involves establishing strong working relationships with neighboring jurisdictions. Relationships are necessary for developing performance capabilities that leverage joint operations, mutual aid,

support local, regional, state to state, and nationwide priorities when responding to a catastrophic event.

The term of the grant will run from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and The Hudson County Board of Commissioners are committed to providing the necessary resources to assist local municipalities in enhancing and sustaining their all-hazards emergency management capabilities.

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
