**AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 784-12-2022
FOR THE HUDSON COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES
TO AWARD WORKFIRST NEW JERSEY FUNDS
TO EDUCATIONAL SERVICE PROVIDERS
JULY 1, 2022 TO JUNE 30, 2023
(\$2,474,484.00)**

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development issued a Notice of Award for State Fiscal Year 2023 which runs from July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023 in the total amount of **SIX MILLION TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO THOUSAND THIRTY-ONE DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$6,221,031.00)**; and

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2022, the Hudson County/Jersey City Workforce Development Board (WDB) issued a competitive Request for Proposals for Workfirst New Jersey Programs from which a contract award was made to the Hudson County Department of Family Services (DFS); and

WHEREAS, the amount awarded to DFS was **FIVE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$5,400,000.00)**; and

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution No. 661-10-2022, this Board authorized contract extensions to Workfirst New Jersey educational service providers; and

WHEREAS, the funds awarded through this resolution were in the amount of **TWO MILLION NINE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTEEN DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$2,925,516.00)**; and

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution No. 784-12-2022, this Board approved an additional award allocation in the amount of **TWO MILLION FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-FOUR THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$2,474,484.00)** for a pending DFS allocation; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Family Services now wishes to award these funds to educational service providers; and

WHEREAS, the specific awards to each provider for the period of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023 is as follows:

3. The Board hereby approves the award of Workfirst New Jersey funds to educational service providers.
4. The Clerk to this Board shall attach a certified copy of this resolution to the filed copies of Resolution Nos. 661-10-2022 and 784-12-2022.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
