Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson to accept funds from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources Services Administration Ryan White HIV/AIDS Part A and B Grant Program totaling \$205,800

Jersey City-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson to accept funds from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources Services Administration Ryan White HIV/AIDS Part A and B grant programs totaling **\$205,800**.

The purpose of the program is to provide services that include outpatient, ambulatory medical care, essential support services, medical case management services and other core medical and social services programs for those living in Hudson County with HIV/AIDS.

The grant will focus on implementing strategies, interventions and approaches designed to reduce new HIV infections in Hudson County.

The County Initiative where a Hudson County Ending HIV Epidemic Plan will be implemented to reach people with HIV who are newly diagnosed, HIV diagnosed and out of care, HIV diagnosed but never in HIV care and those who are not virally suppressed.

The following organizations will receive funds: Care Point Hoboken University Medical

Center, \$18,000, Robert Wood Johnson Barnabas Health Jersey City Medical Center, \$14,000, Hyacinth AIDS Foundation, \$52,440, Hyacinth AIDS Rapid Start, \$49,794, Hyacinth AIDS FOUNDATION, North Hudson Services Expansion, \$33,053, Hyacinth AIDS Foundation, \$20,000, HC Administration, \$18,513, Totaling \$205,800.

The program will run from March 1, 2023 to February 29, 2024.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and The Board of Commissioners are committed to providing the needed financial services, support services, referral services, and prevention services to the residents of Hudson County who are living with HIV/AIDS.
