Jersey City-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the application and acceptance of funds, if awarded, from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention for the Advancing Health Equity for Priority Populations with or at Risk for Diabetes Grant Program.

The county has applied for \$5,500,000 in grant money from the Diabetes Grant Program.

The term of the grant will be from May 30, 2023 through May 29, 2028.

Hudson County Department of Health and Human Services Office on Health Equity propose to support residents with or at risk for developing Type 2 Diabetes by addressing systematic obstacles to accessing health care and other services within Hudson County.

The grant will be used to decrease the risk for type 2 diabetes among adults with prediabetes and improve self-care practices, quality of care, and early detection of complications among people with diabetes.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and The Board of Commissioners are committed to strengthening self-care practices by improving access, appropriateness, and feasibility of diabetes self-management education and support services for priority populations.
