***Hudson County***- The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved funds for Children and Youth Mental Health and Enrichment Program providers for one year, totaling \$500,000.

The County has been informed that it will receive \$500,000 in stimulus funds pursuant to the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Plan Act also known as the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (the “ARP”).

The ARP funds will be utilized for the benefit of Hudson County and its municipalities and eligible agencies to combat the COVID-19 pandemic.

The following agencies are receiving funds under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021: Team Wilderness, \$125,000, The Anti-Violence Coalition of Hudson County, Big Brothers Big Sisters of Essex, Hudson, and Union Counties, \$50,000, Hope and Future, Inc., \$50,000, Kismet of Kings, \$50,000, Team Wilderness, \$50,000, The Anti-Violence

Coalition of Hudson County.

Board Chairman Anthony Romano and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners committed allocated the sum of \$500,000 from the ARP funds to various agencies to provide needed services to County residents.
