TO THE HUDSON COUNTY/JERSEY CITY WORKFORCE
DEVELOPMENT BOARD SEEKING TO APPROVE A THREE (3) MONTH
CONTRACT EXTENSION TO THE HUDSON COUNTY SCHOOLS OF
TECHNOLOGY - CAREER DEVELOPMENT CENTER
FOR THE WORKFORCE INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT (WIOA)
LEARNING LINK PROGRAM THROUGH FUNDS AWARDED
FROM THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND
WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2022
JANUARY 1, 2023 TO MARCH 31, 2023
(NO COST EXTENSION)

WHEREAS, the County of Hudson as Fiscal Agent to the Hudson County/Jersey City Workforce Development Board sought to have approved a six (6) month contract extension to the Hudson County Schools of Technology Career Development Center for the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Adult and Dislocated Worker and Workforce Learning Link Programs through funds from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development for Program Year 2022; and

WHEREAS, by way of WDB Resolution No. 2022-25, funds were allocated to the Hudson County Schools of Technology – Career Development Center in the amount of \$142,919.00 in order to operate the Program Year 2021 WIOA Learning Link Program; and

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution No. 662-10-2022, funds were allocated to the Hudson County Schools of Technology – Career Development Center for PY 2022 WIOA Learning Link Program funds in the amount of \$61,584.00 for the period of July 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the current contracts have now expired and a three (3) month extension is necessary to ensure the uninterrupted continuation and delivery of employment and training services for the above-named program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to correspondence with the State DOL, the extension to the Learning Link component for this three (3) month period has been approved using Program Year 2022/Fiscal Year 2023 funds for the extension period; and

WHEREAS, by way of WDB Resolution No. 2023-07, a three (3) month extension of the contract with the Hudson County Schools of Technology – Career Development Center is warranted from January 1, 2023 to March 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, this grant award is not subject to "Pay to Play" requirements as it pertains to a governmental entity; and

WHEREAS, these funds were provided to the Hudson County/Jersey City Workforce Development Board and it is advantageous for this Board to approve the three (3) month contract extension from January 1, 2023 to March 31, 2023 at no cost to the County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Hudson, that:

1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
