***Hudson County-*** The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved a Behavioral Health and Wellness Response Grant for allocation to various agencies by the County of Hudson for American Rescue Plan Act, totaling \$570,625.

The County has been advised that it will receive \$570,625 in stimulus funds pursuant to the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Plan Act also known as the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (the “ARP”).

The ARP funds will be used for the benefit of Hudson County and its municipalities and eligible agencies to combat the COVID-19 pandemic.

The following agencies are receiving funds under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 Behavioral Health and Wellness Response Grant: family success centers, prevention links \$110,000, Catholic Charities of the Archdiocese of Newark, \$41,250, CoxPhit, \$41,250, Hope and Future, \$41,250, Hopes Community Action, \$41,250, Hunters World, \$41,250,

New City Kids, \$41,250, Partners in Prevention, \$41,250, Mental Health, Partners in Prevention, \$68,750, and Hyacinth AIDS Foundation, \$103,125, which will enhance safety measures by combating the impact of the COVID-19 virus.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners committed allocated the sum of \$570,625 from the ARP funds to various agencies to provide needed services to County residents.
