Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the application and acceptance of a United States Department of Agriculture, Urban and Community Forestry Grant for tree planting along county roads and parks (\$2,236.596)

Jersey City-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the application and acceptance of an USDA, Urban and Community Forestry Grant for tree planting along county roads and parks (\$2,236,596).

The funds will help the county conduct a shade tree inventory along all county roadways right of way within in overburdened communities, a total of about 46.75 miles. This corresponds to all county roads outside of the City of Hoboken.

The county intends to plant approximately 436 trees within seven county parks and approximately 150 trees along county roads.

The grant will allow the county to create a street tree inventory and a comprehensive database of the existing shade trees along county roads. The data collected during the inventory will include tree location, species, approximate age, and tree condition.

Board Chairman Anthony Romano and The Board of Commissioners are committed to planting and restoring trees along county roads and parks.
