Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson to accept funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development so a partnership can be initiated with the Hudson County Continuum of Care Program to oversee the Emergency Housing Vouchers Program totaling \$483,924.

Jersey City-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson to accept funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development so a partnership can be initiated with the Hudson County Continuum of Care Program to oversee the Emergency Housing Vouchers Program, totaling \$483,924.

The funds will be utilized by the Division of Housing and Community Development to help provide housing assistance to homeless individuals. Direct referrals for the program are made through the Continuum of Care Coordinated Entry Program.

The Emergency Housing Vouchers Program provides long term housing vouchers for eligible households, which include households whose income is fifty (50) percent or below the area median income and are homeless, at risk of homelessness or fleeing domestic violence.

The length of the program is from August 1, 2023, to July 31, 2024.

Board Chairman Anthony Romano and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners are committed to addressing the problems of homelessness and aiding those in need of housing.
