**AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 784-12-2022 AND 661-10-2022  
TO EXTEND AND RE-ALLOCATE FUNDS TO A  
FAIR AND OPEN COMPETITIVE CONTRACT  
FROM THE HUDSON COUNTY/JERSEY CITY WORKFORCE  
DEVELOPMENT BOARD TO  
THE HUDSON COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY SERVICES  
FOR THE WORKFIRST NEW JERSEY PROGRAM  
JULY 1, 2022 TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2023  
(\$770,500.00)**

**WHEREAS**, on October 7, 2022, the Hudson County/Jersey City Workforce Development Board (WDB) issued a competitive Request for Proposals (RFP) Program Year 2022 Fiscal Year 2023 Workfirst New Jersey (WFNJ) and Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Employment and Training and General Assistance (GA) Programs; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 21, 2022, on behalf of the Hudson County/Jersey City Workforce Development Board, the New Jersey Department of Labor Office of Career Services recommended for funding, **\$5,400,000.00** to the Hudson County Department of Family Services; and

**WHEREAS**, by way of Resolution No. 661-10-2022, this Board approved awards to Educational Services Providers for the Workfirst New Jersey Program in the amount of **\$2,925,516.00** for the period of July 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, by way of Resolution No. 784-12-2022, this Board approved an additional allocation of funds to the Hudson County Department of Family Services to provide these services for the period of July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023 in the amount of **\$2,474,484.00**; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hudson County/Jersey City Workforce Development Board now wishes to extend the contract with the Department of Family Services until September 30, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the WDB also wishes to re-allocate administrative and program funds in the amount of **SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$770,500.00)** that are projected to be unspent by the obligation period with the approval of the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development and Hudson County/Jersey City Workforce Development Board; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds must be obligated by September 30, 2023 and liquidated by December 31, 2023 or they will be returned to the State; and

**WHEREAS**, the award to Hudson County Family Services by the Hudson County/Jersey City Workforce Development Board as well as the contracts to the service providers are not subject to "Pay to Play" requirements as they emanated from a fair and open competitive process pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Hudson, that:

1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Board hereby authorizes County Executive Thomas A. DeGise, County Administrator, Abraham Antun, Deputy County Administrator, David Drumeler, or their lawfully appointed designee to execute any and all documents and take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this resolution.




