The 2024 Grant is administered through the County of Hudson, and it is awarded to providers that serve Hudson County Juveniles who are at risk and or involved with the family court system. Services will include mentoring, after-school services, community services, delinquency prevention services, electronic monitoring, adolescent treatment, adolescent substance abuse counseling, violence prevention, central stationhouse adjustment, community-based mentoring, and specialized behavioral treatment/sex offender.

The term of the grant will run from January 1, 2024, to December 31, 2024.
