**Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson, Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Inclusion and Accessibility, and Peer Grouping Funds totaling \$442,460.**

**Jersey City-**The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson, Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Inclusion and Accessibility, and Peer Grouping Funds totaling \$442,460.

The funds will be utilized by the Hudson County Department of Health and Human Services to help aid seniors and individuals with disabilities. Peer Grouping funding provides homemaker services, skilled nursing services, case management, emergency mental health services, respite care, hospice, early intervention services, infant/toddler stimulation programs, medical supplies, pharmaceutical services, and home delivered meals for Hudson County's most vulnerable and neediest residents with disabilities. Funding will be provided for the following areas: Assistive Technology, Hospice, Independent Living Case Management, Transition case management and therapeutic recreational services.

The following will receive the Peer Grouping Funds: Act Now Foundation, seniors and adults with disabilities, \$12,000, Act Now Foundation, caregivers of individuals with degenerative/chronic diseases, \$35,000, Catholic Charities of the Archdioceses of Newark, \$10,000, Heightened Independence & Progress, independent living case

management, \$50,000, Heightened Independence & Progress, transition case management, \$30,000, Heightened Independence & Progress, assistive technology, \$55,000, Heightened Independence & Progress, therapeutic services, \$13,460, Jersey City Medical Center/RWJ Barnabas Health, community emergency psychiatric services, \$83,000, Team UP Counseling, therapeutic recreational services, \$12,000, United Cerebral Palsy of Hudson County, respite, \$60,000, St. Josephs School for the Blind, \$20,000, Visiting Homemaker Service of Hudson County, certified home health case management, \$15,000, totaling \$442,460.

The grant period will be from January 1, 2024, to December 31, 2024.

Board Chairman Anthony Romano and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners are committed to addressing and providing the necessary resources to individuals in need of assistance.
