Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved allocation to various agencies under the American Rescue Plan Act, totaling \$481,667.

Hudson County- The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved allocation to various agencies under American Rescue Plan Act, totaling \$481,667.

The County has been advised that it will receive \$481,667 in stimulus funds pursuant to the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Plan Act also known as the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (the “ARP”).

The ARP funds will be used for the benefit of Hudson County and its municipalities and eligible agencies to combat the COVID-19 pandemic.

The following agencies are receiving funds under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2023 Wellness Programs: Sarah’s Daughters, \$141,667, New City Kids, \$85,000, Guazabara Insights, \$85,000, Bayonne Youth Center, \$85,000, She is Incorporated, \$85,000.

Board Chairman Anthony Romano and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners committed allocated the sum of \$481,667 from the ARP funds to various agencies to provide needed services to County residents.
