Hudson County Board of Commissioners Honor, Applaud, and Commend Gennaro (Gene) Romano, Executive Assistant Prosecutor of the Hudson County Prosecutor's Office on his Retirement.

Jersey City-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners honor, applaud, and commend Gennaro (Gene) Romano, Executive Assistant Prosecutor of the Hudson County Prosecutor's Office on his retirement.

Gene Rubino has retired after a distinguished and successful career of over 27 years as an Executive Assistant Prosecutor with the Hudson County Prosecutor's Office. He was born and raised in Jersey City to first generation Italian immigrants.

Gene Rubino was the first in his family to attend law school and was admitted to practice law in New Jersey in 1995. He joined the Office of the Hudson County Prosecutor in 1996 and during his tenure, he was involved in some of the most high-profile cases that came to the office. He served in various roles including assistant prosecutor, chief of staff, and the office spokesperson. Since 2012, Gene Rubino had represented the Prosecutor's Office before the Hudson County Board of County Commissioners.

Gene Rubino has held the role of liaison for numerous key initiatives and events in Hudson County such as the Gun Buy-Back programs and the most extensive Fugitive Safe Surrender program ever conducted in the State. He served on the law enforcement

committee for the Super Bowl at MetLife Stadium. Furthermore, he was a faculty member in statewide programs, including the Undercover Narcotics Investigating Training (U.N.I.T.) course, the Development Education Leadership Training Academy (D.E.L.T.A.) course and the Top Gun course. He previously instructed at the former Jersey City Police Academy and continues to teach at the Hudson County Public Safety Training Center.

Under the guidance and leadership of Hudson County Prosecutor Esther Suarez, Gene Rubino orchestrated the development of the inaugural Hudson County Regional Collision Investigation Unit, the Hudson County Regional SWAT Unit, and the Hudson County Regional Arson Task Force.

Gene Rubino is a member of both the Hudson County Chiefs of Police Association and the New Jersey State Association of Chiefs of Police. He is also a member of the New Jersey State Bar Association and the Hudson County Bar Association. Additionally, he formerly served on the executive board of the Chiefs of County Detectives/Investigators Association of New Jersey.

Gene Rubino has been the recipient of numerous professional honors and awards throughout his career, acknowledging his achievements and dedicated service. These accolades have been conferred by prestigious organizations including the Drug Enforcement Administration, the United States Attorney's Office for the District of New Jersey, and the Jersey City Police Department.
