Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved \$97,390.60 from the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services Grant to address alcohol and drug addiction and recovery

Jersey City-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved \$97,390.60 from the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services Grant to address alcohol and drug addiction and recovery.

The funds will be utilized to help Hudson County municipalities address the issues surrounding alcohol and drug abuse in their communities. These funds will also be used to provide prevention, education, intervention and addiction treatment services to the residents of Hudson County.

These funds will also address prevention, early intervention, treatment and recovery support for Opioid Use Disorder, Outpatient Substance Abuse/ Co-Occurring Treatment Services for adults (age 19 and above, Family Support/Outreach/Education, Medication Assisted Treatment Services for Youth and or Adults, and Early Intervention Substance Use Services for Youth (ages 10 to 18).

The program will run from April 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024.

Board Chairman Anthony Romano and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners are committed to provide funds that will be used towards the reduction of alcohol and drug use by connecting individuals with addiction to medication assisted treatment and supporting individuals on a path to recovery.
