Hudson County- The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved over \$8,498,822 in Open Space Trust Grantees for numerous open space acquisitions, park improvements and historic preservation projects throughout Hudson County.

The City of Bayonne was awarded funds for Peninsula at Bayonne Harbor Waterfront Walkway Extension, \$500,000, Improvements to Veteran's Park, \$250,000.

The Town of Harrison was awarded funds for Policemen's Park Playground Rehabilitation, \$300,000.

The Borough of East Newark was awarded funds for Veteran's Soccer Field Turf, \$167,000.

The City of Hoboken was awarded funds for Hoboken Skate Park and Walkway Upgrades Project, \$250,000, Church Square Park Improvement Project-Phase 1, \$500,000.

The City of Jersey City was awarded funds for Skinner Park Improvements Project, \$500,000, Martiniak-Enright Park Improvements Project, \$250,000, City Hall Park, \$500,000, Jersey City Redevelopment Authority, Bayfront Promenade Park Phase 1, \$500,000.

The Town of Kearny was awarded funds for Kearny Recreational Center Site Improvements, \$150,000.

The Township of North Bergen was awarded funds for Pickleball Court Improvements to Stan Newman Field, \$500,000, Improvements to North Bergen Recreation Center, \$250,000.

The Town of Secaucus was awarded funds for Ivanoski Park Inclusive Playground Project, \$500,000.

The City of Union City was awarded funds for Liberty Place Playground, \$500,000, 4100 Palisade Avenue Soccer Field, \$500,000.

The Township of Weehawken was awarded funds for Louisa Park Improvement Project, \$500,000, Weehawken Pedestrian Bridge and Waterfront Walkway, \$250,000.

The Township of West New York was awarded funds for Filmore Park Improvement Project: Playground, \$330,000, Filmore Park Improvement Project: Safety Improvements, \$300,000.

The Town of Guttenberg was awarded funds for Guttenberg Dog Park Project, \$300,000.

Open Space Land Acquisition Projects: Town of Kearny, \$422,000 for site acquisitions for a continuous Waterfront Recreational Park along the Passaic River.

Historic Preservation Projects: Old Bergen Church, \$100,000 for Old Bergen Church Cemetery Restoration Project, Hudson County Parks, \$179,822 for Historic Preservation of Lincoln Park Sun Houses.

The anticipated start date for these proposed projects is September 26, 2024 through September 25, 2026.

Board Chairman Anthony Romano and the members of the Board of Commissioners are committed to providing the necessary resources needed to assist communities to make capital improvements to parks, acquire open space and preserve historic sites in their

towns or cities within Hudson County.
