**Hudson County Commissioners approved a \$500,000 contract for the Excellent Way Learning Life Center and Re-Vision House to provide housing services for the Re-entry population.**

***Hudson County-*** The Hudson County Board of Commissioners a \$500,000 contract for the Excellent Way Learning Life Center and Re-Vision House to provide housing services for the re-entry population.

Most Excellent Way Learning Life Center provides supportive housing within Hudson County. It has over 10 years of successful partnering with the Division of Community Reintegration. They have a success rate of 90% with clients. Most Excellent Way Learning Life Center has the professional staff in place to provide required wrap around recovery services at both of its Jersey City, New Jersey locations. Both houses are in low crime areas and accessible by public transportation. Each location has multiple beds, bathrooms, kitchens, meeting space and a backyard area.

Most Excellent Way Learning Life Center provides a solid recovery structure including Peer Mentoring and Counseling, Case Management, Individual Residential Treatment Plans, Inhouse Recovery Meetings, Family Reunification, Financial Literacy, Physical Health and Wellness Food, Clothing, Toiletries, and other needed essential daily living in

a safe atmosphere.

Re-Vision House has provided housing and recovery services for New Jersey State Parole during the COVID-19 Pandemic. The management team was trained by one of the top recovery programs in the Northeast, the Connecticut Community for Recovery Addiction. Re-Vision House developed positive working relationships with our local One Stop, New Jersey Reentry Corporation and Prevention Links. Re-Vision House is in a low crime area with 10 beds, 2 kitchens, 4 baths, a meeting room, and a backyard. Re-Vision House provides transportation and round-the-clock in-house staff support and recovery services. They promote mutual respect through proper communication, cleanliness, teamwork, dignity, proper human behavior, and responsibility through their 12 Step Program.

The term of the grant will run from September 1, 2024, to August 31, 2025.

Board Chairman Anthony Romano and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners are providing the necessary resources to assist both organizations in providing housing services for the re-entry population including specifically the Hudson County Division of Reintegration's clients and program.
