The Prosecutor's Office Crime Victim/Witness Advocacy Program provides a broad range of services, which includes notification, transportation arrangements and assistance with recovered property. It also provides crime victims with case information and referral assistance to hospitals, victim aid, supplies, equipment, clinics and social services agencies and purchase of services.

The grant period started July 1, 2024, and will run through June 30, 2025.
