**Jersey City-**The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved the County of Hudson to accept funds from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Health Resources Services Administration Ryan White HIV/AIDS Part A and B grant programs totaling **\$250,000**.

The purpose of the program is to provide services that include outpatient, ambulatory medical care, essential support services, medical case management services and other core medical and social services programs for those living in Hudson County with HIV/AIDS.

The grant will focus on implementing strategies, interventions and approaches designed to reduce new HIV infections in Hudson County.

The County Initiative where a Hudson County Ending HIV Epidemic Plan will be implemented to reach people with HIV who are newly diagnosed, HIV diagnosed and out of care, HIV diagnosed but never in HIV care and those who are not virally suppressed.

The Hudson Pride Center with LGBTQ+ Community will receive \$250,000 to provide

health and wellness services such as HIV care, HIV testing, treatment and health education and create a safe space for members of the LGBTQ+ Community living with HIV in Hudson County.

The program will run from September 15, 2024, to February 28, 2025.

Board Chairman Anthony Romano and The Board of Commissioners are committed to providing the needed financial services, support services, referral services, prevention services, and health education to the residents of Hudson County who are living with HIV/AIDS.

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
