

Hudson County recently adopted the **Vision Zero Safety Action Plan**. The Plan resulted from a collaborative, year-long effort involving the County, municipalities, stakeholders, and residents. The Plan utilizes the **Safe Systems Approach**, which prioritizes designing roads that minimize crash risks and prevent fatalities and serious injuries.

The Plan consists of **20 strategies** and **90+ actions** to address the traffic safety challenges in Hudson County. Ongoing efforts include:

- ✓ Continuing collaboration through the Vision Zero Task Force
- ✓ Launching a Rapid Reponse Team to investigate fatal and serious crashes
- ✓ Designing for safer speeds to protect pedestrians and vulnerable road users
- ✓ Expanding the protected bike network to physically separate cyclists from car traffic
- ✓ Developing a Complete Streets Checklist to guide County transportation projects



The County has set an ambitious Vision Zero goal. With the **support of the local communities and residents, we can meet this challenge** and create safer streets that enhance movement for all road users throughout Hudson County.
