The phone call came from within the Corrections facility. A review of the camera system revealed Officer Medina picked up the phone at the exact time the call was made. Medina admitted to making a prank call.

Surveillance from the incident reveals the inmate crossing the redline around the perimeter of the officer's desk. An argument ensues between the inmate and Office Dhlamini. Officer Dhlamini can be seen challenging the inmate and deploys Oleoresin Capsicum (OC) within inches of the inmate's face as the inmate was walking away. Further, Dhlamini is seen grabbing the inmate's wrists while shoving them with no clear objective to restrain the inmate while continuing to deploy OC another 5 times.

Spilletti was again given a lawful order to lock down the housing unit, which was also disregarded.
