Help may be available!

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT

- Must be a resident of Jersey City
- Must have received a summons for eviction or notice to quit from landlord
- Household must be able to afford the rent going forward and or at the conclusion of the benefit
- Household must meet income guideline below

If you are unable to apply electronically, you can apply via phone by appointment. Please call 201-209-2826 or 201-209-2827 to request a phone interview. If you have already received assistance and continue to need assistance, please apply you may be eligible for further assistance. You may also apply in person by visiting us at 257 Cornelison Ave in Jersey City. Please present at window 1 or 2.
