



1 MR. OSTASZEWSKI: Good morning,  
2 everyone. My name is Jimmy Ostaszewski. I am the  
3 Coordinator of Hudson County Transit and  
4 Transportation. We welcome you here today for a  
5 public hearing for the acceptance, application for  
6 acceptance of SCDRTAP funding from New Jersey  
7 Transit, the State of New Jersey.

8 I'd like to have everybody just introduce  
9 themselves. We can start going around the table.

10 MS. SOLIS: Millie Solis, Grants  
11 Administrator for New Jersey Transit.

12 MR. JORDAN: Patrick Jordan.

13 MR. MARTINEZ: Stephen Martinez,  
14 Director of Scheduling.

15 MR. RYAN: William Ryan, also from  
16 TRANSCEND.

17 MR. MICELE: Jeff Micele, Driver.

18 MR. PAREDES: Alex from Hayden  
19 Independence and Progress.

20 MR. OSTASZEWSKI: We're here today  
21 for two basic reasons. One is to explain the budget  
22 for TRANSCEND, where our funding sources come from.  
23 Two is to go over some of the goals that we have set  
24 for the year 2025. So first, I'd like to discuss  
25 our funding.

1           The SCDRTAP funding, which is for Senior  
2 Citizens and Disabled Residents, the Transportation  
3 Assistance Program is for transportation for seniors  
4 and disabled here in Hudson County. That funding  
5 this year that we will receive, which is based off  
6 casino revenue, which is a percentage given to the  
7 State of New Jersey and divided among the counties  
8 in New Jersey. That funding will total \$2,054,388.  
9 That is a slight increase from approximately \$1.8  
10 million that we received the year before.

11           Other sources of funding that we have come  
12 from the Veterans Department. That is for \$15,000,  
13 and that remains the same from the previous year.  
14 For Title III, an approximate amount that we will  
15 have for the year 2025, will be \$260,000. We also  
16 anticipate 5310 Funding, which could be  
17 approximately about \$150,000, if we were basing it  
18 on previous years. Sometimes that could go up,  
19 sometimes it could go down a little. We also have  
20 funding remaining from the Coronavirus Act and that  
21 is \$300,000. We add that all up and it comes to  
22 approximately \$2,700,000.

23           The budget for TRANSCEND, for  
24 administration, operating is normally around \$4.8  
25 million for the year, and once again, that could go

1 up based on salary increases and what the benefits  
2 do cost. So the remaining amount of that money  
3 comes from Hudson County, County Commissioners, and  
4 the County Exec's Office. Hudson County is still  
5 one of the few counties here in New Jersey that does  
6 not charge any fares for the people that use the  
7 system. According to the County Exec and  
8 Commissioners, that has been told to me that will  
9 continue for as long as they're in office. So that  
10 is good to hear for all of our residents that use  
11 the service.

12 The next part that I have to discuss is we  
13 need to always set some goals for TRANSCEND for the  
14 upcoming year. So we did set three goals. One was  
15 to increase, or actually to update our vehicle  
16 inventory. So we have recently put out a bid for  
17 four new vehicles, eight seats with two wheelchairs  
18 accessible. We anticipate that bid to probably take  
19 a month or so. By the time we get it, we'll  
20 initiate the process starting in 2025, and hopefully  
21 have those vehicles in 2025. That is \$440,000 cost  
22 that the County has put in themselves for those  
23 vehicles. So that is our main goal, number one.

24 Number two, we talk about increasing  
25 ridership each year. So our goal normally is to say

1 we'd like to increase ridership by a conservative  
2 five percent. So for the year 2023, we did  
3 approximately 85,000 trips. For 2024, we are on  
4 schedule to increase that number. So that number  
5 should go up by a couple percent, but probably  
6 around 88,000, 90,000 trips. So we do anticipate  
7 that, once again, increasing in 2025.

8 Our third goal will be receiving  
9 additional funding. So the County has a grant  
10 writer now whose job is to basically look for grants  
11 that could possibly help to give us additional  
12 funding for transportation of the seniors and  
13 disabled. So we have been in communication with  
14 them. They know what we're looking for, and  
15 hopefully, they can find a few extra dollars to help  
16 TRANSCEND.

17 We will be starting a coordinated  
18 transportation plan update, which actually we'll  
19 initiate today. We're hoping this plan, when done,  
20 will give us the ability, one, possibly more  
21 funding, possibly to add additional trips, and to  
22 close some of the gaps in areas that we are short  
23 for, perhaps some shortcomings, such as in the  
24 mornings, later at night, and on weekends. But to  
25 provide those kind of services, we will need to come

1 up with additional vehicles, drivers, and funding,  
2 and if we can make that happen, it would be a  
3 beautiful start to the year of 2025.

4 At this point, I would like to open up the  
5 floor for any comments that anybody would like to  
6 add?

7 That is it. That ends our public hearing  
8 today. Thank you very much.

9 (Whereupon the proceeding is then  
10 concluded at 10:11 a.m.)


