

# BOAT RAMP RULES:



- A. The use of boat ramp is for boats only. Personal watercrafts (including but not limited to Wave Runners, Jet Skis, Jet Boars, etc.) are prohibited from using the boat ramp.
- B. The use of boat ramp is limited to kayaks, canoes, and boats measuring (24) twenty-four feet or less.
- C. No person shall tie up or leave any vessel in the area around any launching ramps, floats or docks, except when loading or unloading cargo and/passengers.
- D. Wheeled vehicles, including trailers, shall be parked at designed places only.
- E. The use of environmentally safe, biodegradable soaps and detergents are allowed. All others are prohibited.
- F. Swimming from docks, floats, boat launching ramps and areas posted “no swimming” is prohibited.
- G. Storage of boats, trailers, vehicles, equipment, and any other property at the launching facility and within County parks is prohibited.
- H. Children (12) years old and younger must wear a PFD (Life Vest) while on docks and while boarding and disembarking boats.
- I. Fueling of any vessels is not permitted at the boat dock or boat launch area.
- J. Docking is permitted for (10) ten minutes only.
- K. In the event that a vessel or trailer shall for any reason sink or become disabled while at the boat ramp or boat launch, hindering safe access to other boaters, the County may take immediate steps to remove the vessel or trailer. All costs will be at the owner’s expense.

**Violators are subject to imprisonment in county jail, not to exceed ninety (90) days, and or up to a \$500 fine.**
