**AMENDING RESOLUTION NOS. 453-7-2017 AND 546-9-2017
TO DE-OBLIGATE AND RE-ALLOCATE FUNDS
TO VENDORS FOR THE CONTINUATION OF
WORKFIRST NEW JERSEY (WFNJ) SERVICES
JULY 1, 2017 TO JUNE 30, 2018
(\$463,000.00)**

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution No. 453-7-2017, this Board accepted funds from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development for Workfirst New Jersey Allotments and awarded funds to educational services providers through a fair and open process for Workfirst New Jersey, Welfare Reform Program; and

WHEREAS, by way of Resolution No. 546-9-2017, this Board approved the option for year two of fair and open contracts for Workfirst New Jersey occupational training services; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Family Services now seeks to de-obligate and re-allocate Department of Labor and Workforce Development funds for Workfirst New Jersey services to various service providers in the amount of **FOUR HUNDRED SIXTY THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND 00/100 (\$463,000.00)**; and

WHEREAS, the de-obligation and re-allocation of funds and the ensuing contract awards are not subject to "Pay to Play" requirements as they emanated from a fair and open competitive process pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1; and

WHEREAS, the shift in funding represents the Department's ongoing effort to allocate funds to performing agencies and reduce funds that are awarded to underperforming agencies and the movement of funds also allows the Department to expend remaining funds and pay for services already provided by the vendors; and

WHEREAS, the contracts are for the period of July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018 and represent funding for various employment, basic education skills training, and job search readiness services to Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), and General Assistance (GA) and Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program (SNAP) clients; and

WHEREAS, the following recommendations are consistent with New Jersey regulations in the stated amounts:


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Hudson that:

Drumeler, or their lawfully appointed designee, to execute any and all documents and take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this Resolution.
3. The Board hereby approves the de-obligation and re-allocation of grant funds from the New Jersey State Department of Labor and Workforce Development for Workfirst New Jersey activities which funds will be re-allocated to educational services providers for educational services.
4. The Board hereby approves the fair and open contracts with educational services providers for Workfirst New Jersey services.
5. The Clerk to this Board shall attach a certified copy of this Resolution to the filed copies of Resolution Nos. 453-7-2017 and 546-9-2017.
6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
